Interim protection plan developed and implemented for the sanctuary. Long-term protection and monitoring plan initiated and a draft produced. Regular ranger's patrols conducted.

A draft training plan for the sanctuary staff was developed on the protection and monitoring. A significant proportion of the sanctuary infrastructure and staff equipment was acquired, including the purchase of a 4 WD vehicle.

The demarcation of the boundaries of the sanctuary is almost completed. Regular maintenance operations were equally conducted.

Meetings with traditional rulers council were initiated with communities and will be pursued every six months. Sanctuary staff and community meetings were also conducted.
