The Seed Bank continues to run smoothly and collecting is continuing at a steady pace, allowing for the usual seasonal variation caused by climatic factors. The current list of species collected stands at around 190 species, or close to two-thirds of the target, with 7 months left to run. 39 of those species are classed as Critically Endangered, 47 Vulnerable and 2 Extinct in the Wild. Collecting was assisted by visits from Sam Crosfield and Tessa Mills, Kew Diploma students, who both received travel scholarships to visit Mauritius and work with the Seed Bank team.
